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Dear Parents,

National Reading and Numeracy Tests- Well, the national tests are over! I would like to thank the pupils for their hard work and efforts. The results will go out to parents at the end of the summer term, usually the second week in July.

Once again, I would like to re-iterate that the tests are used for diagnostic purposes to inform school staff when planning provision for each pupil as they go up to their new classes in September. However, these assessments are only one facet of assessment here at Ysgol y Llys. We look at the whole child development which focuses not only on literacy and numeracy development but also their personal and social development, their ability to interact with adults and their peers, their ability to be creative, to sing, dance and to play sports. Please praise your child for their efforts and celebrate their wide-ranging successes!

Walking to School Day (11.05.18) - This Friday, we will be holding a 'Walking to School Day'.

We would be very grateful if as many families as possible take part. You may choose to walk the full distance from home or only part way (depending on distance and circumstances!) It is parent's responsibility to ensure each child arrives safely at school. The Green Group Echo Committee have suggested the idea and would like to promote the idea of families walking to school together. It will help reduce our school carbon footprint, reduce congestion on Princes Avenue and also help set the children up for the day through having a brisk walk to ensure a healthy start to the day (And parents, if you wear a fitbit, will contribute to your daily 10,000 steps!) Staff also would like to support and those living a distance from school intend to drive part of the way and walk from designated areas to school. The Green Group will afterwards review the initiative and feedback to staff, pupils and parents. Please support!

Safeguarding Update- As a school, we appreciate that many families' circumstances change and this could represent a change in routine for pupils. This might be in the form of arrangements for pupil drop off and pick up to and from Ysgol y Llys. If parents wish to ensure that only one specific person or parent pick up their child, please inform the school appropriately- in written for in a letter or email to school. Please address any changes to the attention of the class teacher who will then pass onto the school administration /secretary who will in turn update the school database. Likewise, if parents have a change of address or mobile contact numbers / emergency contact numbers / pupil allergies, PLEASE ensure these details have been passed onto school.
