Dear Parents,

*A big thank you parents for all your support to Ysgol y Llys over the last twelve months. We wish the pupils who will be transferring to High School the best in the future and we look forward to welcoming 56 new pupils into the nursery class at Ysgol y Llys this September. I would like to thank all the staff for their hard work and dedication to the school. We are fortunate to have such a strong school staff. Diolch. I would also like to thank the Governing Body members for their continuous support and to thank the Chairperson, Mr Mike O'Meara for his support in his first twelve months in post. I appreciate the support of the whole Governing Body who actively work in the best interests of the school and the pupils.*

**Staffing:** *We wish Miss Alaw Pugh-Jones (Dyfrdwy Class teacher, Under 12 Unit) the best as she finishes post next week. She will take up a new post as Secondary school teacher at Holywell High this September. Pob lwc Miss Jones.*

**School Meal Service-** *It has been confirmed that there will be increase in school meal costs from September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 onwards. The increase will see a school meal price increase from £2.10 to £2.20. This equates to a weekly cost of £11.00 per pupil (Increase from £10.50 per week previously). Denbighshire CC Catering Service have also revised their procedures regarding School Meal Debts. From September 1<sup>st</sup> onwards, the maximum school debt allowed per pupil will be £11.00 (The maximum debt currently allowed is £20.00). The limit has been reduced because the total school meals debt for the authority runs into thousands of pounds and is on the increase.*

*A polite reminder that it is parent's responsibility to ensure that sufficient funds are on Parent Pay and to ensure that you keep your accounts up to date. County have instructed schools that if pupils exceed the debt limit that we are then obliged to serve a sandwich and drink. This procedure to apply for three days only if the debt remains. It is not the intention to prevent pupils from receiving school meals but to make parents aware that steps are being taken to reduce such large debts.*

**Health and Safety-** *It has been brought to our attention that numerous families are parking cars on zig-zag lines outside the main school gates. Would parents please refrain from doing this. In September the local police and Denbighshire officers will be monitoring and those found parking in these areas could face fixed penalty fines. Thanks for your anticipated support.*

**Year 6 Farewell Service-** *Many thanks to parents who attended the end of Year 6 farewell service. It was a mixture of emotions! Thanks to Mrs Nikki Barlow (PTA Chair) for presenting gifts to the pupils on behalf of the PTA and to Mr Mike O'Meara for presenting gifts on behalf of the school.*

**Sponsored Walks Update (Urdd 2020) -** *At last, a slight change in weather! As it is the last week of term, we will look to re-schedule the walks for the first few weeks of the new term. On a positive note, it allows pupils some additional time to gather new sponsors for the walks! Many thanks! However, for Year 6 pupils who will be finishing at the end of term, we will look to arrange their walk for next Tuesday (Same arrangements apply as was previously mentioned).*

**End of term-** *School closes for the end of term next Friday (July 20<sup>th</sup>) and will re-open for pupils on Wednesday September 5<sup>th</sup>.*
