**National Reading and Numeracy Tests-** *The national tests will be undertaken in Wales in all schools between 2<sup>nd</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> May, 2018. Our specific timetable will go out electronically to parents as an attachment later on today.*

*\*Please remember- The tests are only ONE method of how we gather information regarding assessment on our pupils. They are tests which are undertaken under strict test criteria, on specific dates and under specific time constraints. Remember, we look at the whole child profile and look at the progress each child has made over time. We also factor in other important elements, e.g. creative developments, skills in arts and crafts, sporting achievements, musical achievements etc. Also, vitally important is the personal and social development of each child, their interaction with their peers, with adults, the respect they have for their elders, appreciation of their local community and of the Welsh culture and language. Please do not put your children under too much pressure in preparation for the tests- undoubtedly they will have enough pressure as they get older. The purpose of the tests is to aid teacher's understanding and knowledge of each pupil's strengths and areas to develop. The tests are a diagnostic tool, to be used in a much wider context. Please remember this. Thanks.*
