Dear Parents,

New Parent Governors- We had two nominations for the role of Parent Governors for the two spaces on the Governing Body. I would like to congratulate Mr David Lloyd (father of Elijah Bl.4) and Mrs Claire Jones-Rowe (Mother of Gethin Bl.2 and Carys, Reception Class) who have been appointed as Parent representatives on the Governing Body. (There was no need for a parent's ballot as both nominations automatically filled the vacancies). Congratulations to both of them and we look forward to their contribution and support on the Governing Body.

Morning pupil 'drop off' arrangements- Just a reminder regarding pupil 'drop off' arrangements in the mornings. With pupils now being back in school for two weeks, just a gentle reminder that pupils in Years 1,2,3,4,5 and 6 are to walk up the drive independently of their parents. (Parents of Under 5 Unit pupils are permitted to bring their children to the Unit as usual. This is in place for various reasons.

1. **Health and Safety-** A large number of parents are congregating on site adjacent to the school yard. It is difficult for staff to monitor who is exactly on site. Parents are also staying on site until the bell rings at 8.55am.
2. As a result of this, the car park 'drop off' facility is not working. The bays have filled and parents do not return to their cars until after the school bell has rung. Other families in cars are therefore having increased difficulties in dropping off. The bays are not for 'long stay' parking, but rather a drop off point for pupils to disembark safely. (Remember, we have two members of staff on duty at the drop off point.

If parents wish to talk to a member of staff or have any enquiries to make at school reception, then of course, parents are allowed on site. I hope parents understand this and will conform to the above request. The system also helps aid pupil independence and social interaction with their peers as they often walk up the drive with their friends. From our experience as well, parents are more nervous about the above system than the pupils themselves!

MacMillan Coffee Morning 23.09.16- Next Friday, (September 23rd, 2016), we will be holding a Cake and Coffee Morning in aid of MacMillan Cancer Support. Pupils are invited to bring in cakes and biscuits for the stall and may bring in some pocket money to buy cakes during the morning break. Parents are invited to attend the Coffee Morning (which will be held in the school dining room between 9.15am-10.00am)
