Music Co-Operative Project Performance 'Culhwch and Olwen'-Pupils in Years 5 and 6 are currently working on a musical and theatrical collaboration with Denbighshire Music Co-Operative. Together with Angharad Llwyd (S4C 'Rownd a Rownd' actress) and Wynn Pearson (Musical peripatetic guitar tutor) they have developed a performance based on the Welsh legend 'Culhwch and Olwen' (from the ancient Welsh literary 'Mabinogion' tales.) This project is school funded and utilises school budget designated for creative/musical opportunities for pupils.

The project will be premiered at Ysgol y Llys on Monday, 2nd July, 2018. School pupils and staff will enjoy the performance by the Under 12 Unit at 1.30pm and later that day at 4.30pm parents will be invited to the school hall to attend and enjoy the performance. Please keep this date in your diaries. There are **no** other dates scheduled to perform this project. (Further details to follow regarding costumes/props/tickets etc.).

Home work- It has been brought to my attention from staff that unfortunately an increasing number of pupils are either not completing or returning homework tasks set by staff. Just a polite reminder that we expect pupils to return completed homework tasks promptly to school. If tasks are not completed or returned, the school policy is for the work to be undertaken by pupils during break times/lunch times. The key principle being is that in setting homework tasks associated with class theme work it bridges pupil's learning between school and home and also allows parents to communicate about what their child is learning at school.
