Defnyddio ap Tric a Chlic i ymarfer sgiliau darllen ac ysgrifennu.

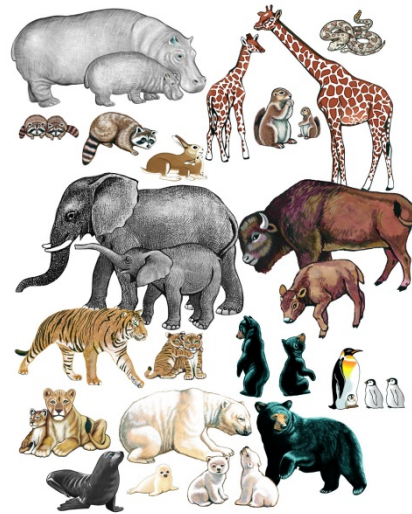
Chwarae gemau iaith fel 'lotto', snap a pharu llun â llythyren/gair.

Dysgu siapiau PESS yn y wers Ymarfer Corff. Defnyddio mat a mainc. Trafod y Pengwin, yr arth a'u cynefin. 'Byd Bach Oer' fel Pegwn y Gogledd a Phegwn y De. A byd bach y Jyngl. Dysgu stori Santes Dwynwen.

## Iaith/language

Practise remembering the 'Tric a Chlic' letters and start to build words. Read the 'Tric a Chlic' books. Enjoy looking at the story, 'Annwyl Sŵ'. Create a story wall by making a border and writing labels for the wall.

Write a letter of thanks.

Use 'I pads', pencils and felt pens to practise forming letters and simple words independently or with spelling prompts.

Use the Tric a Chlic app to learn letter sounds and symbols.

Play word games such as lotto games, snap and pairing letters/words with pictures.

Play a variety of language games and activities in the outside area.

## Wild Animals



## Rhif/Numeracy

Practise forming numbers from 0-10 correctly.

Recognise and use 1p, 2p, and 5p coins to pay for items when role playing.

Organise numbers from 1-10

Introduce the concept of adding two groups of objects to find out how many there are altogether. Practice adding with objects and start to record. Learn to recognise and understand the meaning of the + sign.

Use multilink blocks to measure objects and learn to use the terms 'longer than/shorter than' in Welsh.

Start 'taking away' objects in practical activities in order to calculate how many are left.

**Please practise the above skills with your son/daughter.**

## Ardaloedd/Areas of learning

Paint a picture of one of their Christmas presents. Practise scissor skills and printing to create wild animals. Paint pictures of wild animals. Work as a group to create a jungle collage. Listen to Welsh popular music. Learn Welsh songs about wild animals. Use untuned instruments to practise rhythm and beat.

Learn the PESS shapes in gymnastics. Use mats and benches.

Discuss the penguin, the polar bear and their habitat. Make an igloo and an igloo corner. Create a 'Small World' area based on the North and South Poles. Learn about the story of Saint Dwynwen.

Create an ice cream shop for the role-playing corner in the outside area.

Observe what happens when ice starts to melt in the water.

## What you can do to help:

*Help your child to practise forming letters correctly whilst writing their name.*

*Use and talk about 1p/2p/5p with your child.*

*Help your child to practise 'one more than/one less than' with numbers up to 10.*

*Talk with your child about the 'Stop. Look. And Listen' rules whilst crossing the road. Practise using these rules together.*

*Play 'I spy with my little eye...' to help your child to recognise the first sound of words.*
