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Dear Parents,

Drop off and Pick up Arrangements- Many thanks to you all for your support since we have changed our pick up / drop off arrangements for pupils. It has in many ways being a 'trial and error' process which we continue to monitor and evolve. The electronic lock on the school gate onto the yard has been a good addition to site security and we are considering options to improve issues on the gate from the school yard onto the drive (Issue of mud and difficulty opening gate are being reviewed). Many thanks for your continued support. Fundamentally, the rationale is in moving the bottle neck away from the drop off point in order to reduce risk of potential accidents / collisions between pedestrians and vehicles.

Please note- NO vehicles are allowed up the drive (8.40-9.10yb and 2.40pm-3.30pm.) This is due to the fact pedestrians make use of the drive during drop off/ pick up times. There are **no** exceptions to this rule.

Online Safety / Social Media Update- We have noticed since the start of this new term an increase in parents' comments on Facebook and other social media platforms which sometimes include factually incorrect statements or potentially libellous/ derogatory comments in relation to school. Can I please re-iterate, if you are not sure of anything in relation to school, pick up the telephone to ask school staff or pop in to talk to us! Very often it can clear up any misunderstanding. We do not doubt the benefits of social media. The concern is that once something is posted onto the web, it can be shared/doctored/used/misinterpreted. Think before posting! With this in mind, we have organised a Parents Information Session on Internet Safety with the Educational Psychologist, Mr Michael Duke. The session will be held on Monday, February 10th at 5pm in the school hall. We kindly ask that all families send **at least one** representative to this session. It should only last approx. 1 hour. Thanks for your support.

S4C Filming- Next Thursday, January 23rd, a television crew will be filming an episode of the S4C programme 'Iaith ar Daith'. It is a series which follows Welsh celebrities as they attempt to learn Welsh. In addition, Carol Vorderman will be returning to her Prestatyn roots and will be supporting a Year 3 maths lesson at Ysgol y Llys! Currently, we do not know when the episode will be aired on tv. A reminder to parents who have received consent forms to return them to school as soon as possible.
