Dear Parents,

**Re: Ysgol y Llys ongoing provision from next week for specific groups of pupils**

Here is the latest update for parents regarding revised provision at Ysgol y Llys which will be in place from Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> onwards.

- School will be open **ONLY** for those pupils whose parents work for key workers lists and for other vulnerable groups. Those who have registered have been placed on a data base and will receive an email today confirming arrangements. It will request parents to confirm days pupils will attend next week. This will enable Ysgol y Llys to prepare adequate staffing levels.
- We will have limited number of staff in place specifically to support these pupils and we will group them into Foundation Phase and KS2 pupils.
- The provision will be childcare rather than specific lesson teaching.
- The hours of school will be between 9.00-3.00pm. Pupils may be on site at 8.40am onwards.
- Unfortunately, we will **not** be able to provide Clwb Llawen y Llys or free breakfast club.
- The Cylch Meithrin facility will continue to be open in conjunction with WAG guidance.
- School meals service will be in place for the pupils on site during the day.
- All pupils will be registered against our data base- Please, if you do not fall into the categories, we do not expect them on site.
- The arrangements will be in place for the week March 23-27<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
- Staff will be placed on a rota basis.
- If pupils or families show symptoms of high fever or new persistent cough, they should not be on site. If you have been asked to self-isolate, again, you should not be on site.

We will monitor closely these arrangements and respond to the daily updates and guidance. They are subject to change and may happen at short notice.

To reiterate once again, we acknowledge the confusion is causing some families to be worried about the situation but we can only respond as quickly as the information reaches us.

The authority is planning Central hubs as back up Child Care support centres. Once confirmation arrives we will update parents.

We understand and appreciate that these are worrying times for all. We are entering uncharted territories and will adapt and respond as positively as we can.

Those who have emailed school regarding Key Workers request should receive a confirmation email later today. **Please, if you do not require child care for next week, do not send your child in unless you cannot make alternative arrangements.** We will continue to update you regarding developments in relation to Ysgol y Llys.

The arrangements are in place for next week.
