1. Oriau agor: Os gwelwch yn dda, cofiwch gadw at amseroedd cyrraedd yn y bore fesul Uned.

Uned dan 7- 9:30yb

Uned dan 9- 9:15yb

Uned dan 12- 9:00yb

Rhieni plant dosbarth Derbyn- a fyddwch gystal ag aros wrth giât y Cylch Meithrin wrth ollwng eich plant yn y bore- daw staff yr Uned i hebrwng y plant i'w dosbarth.

2. Pecyn Bwyd- Cofiwch, mae'r Sir yn darparu pecyn bwyd am ddim amser cinio i bob disgybl. Serch hyn, rhaid i bob plentyn gofio ddod a diod/potel o ddŵr efo nhw i'r ysgol.

Os oes anhawster ynglŷn â'r pecyn bwyd, neu os oes gan eich plentyn cyflwr iechyd sy'n golygu mai dim ond bwyd o'r cartref gall ei fwyta, cysylltwch â'r ysgol i wneud trefniadau i ddod a phecyn bwyd eich hunain. Pwysleisir-fel arall dim ond PECYN BWYD o'r ysgol, sydd am ddim gaiff ei gynnig / ei derbyn yn yr ysgol.

3. Rhieni sy'n dewis peidio a gyrru eu plant yn ol i'r ysgol- Mae nifer o geisiadau gan rieni wedi dod wythnos yma yn gofyn am le i'w plant yn yr ysgol oherwydd eu bod wedi newid meddwl neu am resymau eraill. Cofiwch-gofynnwn am 5 diwrnod o rybudd, er mwyn i ni ddiweddarau / addasu amserlenni a rota staffio. Ni chewch yrru eich plentyn i'r ysgol oni bai ei fod wedi cytuno a'ch bod wedi derbyn cadarnhad swyddogol ar e-bost gan yr ysgol.

4. Trefniadau dros yr haf- Nid ydym wedi derbyn diweddariad gan y Sir neu gan Gynulliad Cymru am drefniadau ar gyfer gweithwyr allweddol sy'n dymuno gwasanaeth gofal plant dros wyliau'r haf. Ond mae wedi ei awgrymu na fydd yn cael ei leoli ar safle ysgolion, ond yn hytrach yn cael ei gynnig ar leoliad allanol megis Canolfan Hamdden. Mae wedi awgrymu hefyd y caiff ei staffio gan staff canolog adran Hamdden yr Awdurdod. Disgwyliwn ddiweddariad yn fuan gan yr Awdurdod. Byddwn yn eich hysbysu cyn gynted a chawn wybodaeth.

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Dear Parents,

I sincerely hope your child/children enjoyed their first session back at Ysgol y Llys. As a staff, we have loved seeing the children again, all be it in slightly different circumstances to what they were used to back in March. We feel the 'check in sessions are helpful in preparing the children for the 'new norm', for what will be in place do doubt for quite a long time. We also are grateful to see how the children and parents have respected the social distancing measures put in place at Ysgol y Llys. Diolch

A few observations from the first week back.

1. Opening Hours: *A polite reminder to everyone to adhere to the drop off times in the mornings.*

Reception Class- 9:45am

Under 7 Unit- 9:30am

Under 9 Unit- 9:15am

Under 12 Unit- 9:00am

**Reminder! If you have more than one sibling at school- in the morning please use the latest drop off (For example- with a child in both Reception and Year 6 children, drop both off at 9:45am and pick up both at 2:00pm)*

Reception Class- *Would parents kindly wait by the Cylch Meithrin gate to transfer children to staff rather than walking through the back of the Unit to main reception class entrance.*

2. School Meal Offer- *Denbighshire Catering Service are kindly offering a free packed lunch for ALL pupils. Parents however will need to provide a drink/bottle of water.*

*If pupils have any **medical conditions** which means they are not allowed the school offer of a packed lunch, please notify the head teacher. Otherwise, ALL pupils are expected to have the packed lunch. (Pupils may choose either ham, cheese or tuna sandwich in the morning during registration). Parents also have the option of picking their child up from school at lunchtime to take home, should they not wish to take up the offer.*

3. Parents who have made the decision to keep their children at home - *A number of parents have contacted school this week wishing to re-consider their decision and would like their children to attend the 'check in' sessions. As you can appreciate, in order to limit class bubbles to no more than 7 pupils at one time, there is a strict staffing rota we need to adhere to. We kindly ask that any changes would be reliant upon a 5*

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day notification allowing pupils to attend the following week. Parents will require a confirmation email from school confirming space. Thank you for your understanding.

4. Arrangements over the Summer- *As of today, we are still awaiting confirmation of arrangements for child care provision for children of critical key workers. The Education Minister, Kirsty Williams AM has indicated that it will be provided by Local Authorities, and not by schools. It is also expected to be run by central Denbighshire Staff rather than school-based staff. We will notify parents as soon as any information reaches us.*

We can confirm however...

*Clwb Llawen y Llys will be closed over the summer holidays.
Cylch Meithrin y Llys will be closed over the summer holidays.*

Cars on Site- *We kindly ask that parents who are dropping their children off at 8:30am for the key worker provision, please park their cars in the drop off point and walk their children to the main entrance. This is to limit number of vehicles that are using the staff car park in the mornings. Thank you.*

Once again, we are really pleased to welcome the children back to school. The focus is certainly on wellbeing and ensuring the children have an idea of how the school will look and operate when they return in September. Can I also thank parents for their support in all facets relating to online/distance learning, adhering to school arrangements etc.

We certainly live in testing times, but I have no doubt that once this is all over, we will have a greater appreciation of small things. It has given us all a time to reflect on what is really important and hopefully an opportunity to re-enforce values- importance of supporting each other in times of crisis and change.
