Annwyl Rieni,

Gan obeithio i bawb fwynhau'r ychydig ddiwrnodau yn yr ysgol ar ddechrau'r hanner tymor yma. Yn sicr, bu i ni fel staff fwynhau cwmni'r plant- braf oedd clywed lleisau chwerrhin, bwrlwm plant a profi staff yn dysgu wyneb wrth wyneb eto. Ychydig o sylwadau cyffredinol yn dilyn yr wythnos gyntaf yma.

1. **PARCIO-** Yn wahanol i pan oedd gennym Hwb yn unig ar y safle, yn amlwg felly mae nifer rieni a cherbydau wedi cynyddu'n sylweddol. Nodyn cwrtais i'ch atgoffa i ddefnyddio'r fynediad cywir wrth ddod i fewn i safle'r ysgol (Mae nifer annisgwyl o geir yn defnyddio'r allanfa fel mynediad am ryw rheswm).
2. **PARCIO ANABL-** Gofynnwn yn garedig i chwi fod yn ystyrion o eraill, a dim ond defnyddio'r man parcio anabl os oes gennych hawl i'w ddefnyddio- mae'n bwysig arddangos bathodyn glas os ydych yn defnyddio'r man yma. Os na fydd bathodyn glas yn weladwy, yna bydd staff yn gofyn i chwi barcio rywle arall.
3. **PELLTER CYMDEITHASOL-** Da yw gweld rhieni yn cadw at reolau pellter cymdeithasol- mae hyn yn galonogol iawn. Cofiwch ddilyn yr arwyddion melyn sydd wedi'w paentio ar y ffordd- rhain oll i gyfyngu pobl rhaid cerdded yn erbyn eu gilydd.

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Dear Parents,

Firstly, we hope that everyone has enjoyed the partial re-opening of the school this week. I can certainly confirm how happy the staff were to see the children once again. It was great hearing laughter; the buzz and excitement of friendships being re-formed and face to face teaching on site again. With it also being a short week for those pupils on site, hopefully, the oncoming weekend will prove to be quite a smooth one with everyone eagerly looking forward to returning for the whole week, next week. Hopefully, we can also look forward to welcoming back the Junior pupils in a few weeks. Once again, once we receive any information in relation to this, we will update parents as soon as possible.

General observations of the re-opening week:

- PARKING**- *In contrast to when the school was only open to children of key workers, the numbers on site have increased substantially, and therefore naturally the number of vehicles dropping off pupils has increased. Please ensure that everyone uses the correct entrance point, when entering school site. (An unexpected number of vehicles have unsuccessfully attempted to enter the site via the exit point). Thanks for the anticipated response.*
- DISABLED PARKING**- *As you are no doubt aware, we have limited parking spaces in the car park drop off point for those with disabilities. We have one bay which is clearly marked for disabled users only and those who park there should be eligible to do so. We would also expect users to display the official blue badge at all times. It appears many vehicles are not adhering to this and this is unfair to those who have a right to park and are therefore being discriminated against. Please be mindful of this. If cars are parked without the official blue badge on display, they will be asked by staff to move the vehicle. Once again, thanks for your ongoing support.*
- SOCIAL DISTANCING**- *Parental response to our social distancing guidelines has been really positive. Thanks for this. Please remember to follow the yellow painted arrows on the pathway which indicate the one-way system. This will reduce congestion and people walking past each other if using the single pathway only.*
- WATER BOTTLES**- *Just to confirm that all pupils may bring a bottle of water to school and can be allowed to drink at any time they so wish. A reminder that all Foundation Phase pupils also receive daily drink of milk. We kindly ask that class drink is a bottle of water. Flavoured drinks/fruit cordials are only allowed as part of children's packed lunch. If having school dinner, the drink served will*

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always be water. If you have any queries in relation to this, please contact your class teacher via Class Dojo.

WORLD BOOK DAY- On Thursday, March 4th it is World Book Day. Under normal circumstances we would invite pupils to come to school dressed as a character from a book and to bring their favourite book into school. This year however, we would like to invite pupils to submit a photograph onto their class dojo account, of themselves reading a book of their choice, (Welsh or English) with either a parent, sibling or another member of extended family (who are part of their family bubble). We hope to collect photographs to put on display in school in a collage celebrating World Book Day- we look forward to seeing the photos!

ST. DAVID'S DAY- Next Monday, will be March 1st- St David's Day! This occasion is always a very important one in the Ysgol y Llys calendar. With this in mind, pupils and staff are invited to come to school in Welsh costume, or in red, green or white clothes. We appreciate children may have grown out of previous costumes and parents will not be able to purchase new clothes due to the current climate, but pupils may choose to wear any red, green, white clothing you may already have at home. We are also crossing our fingers that it will be an ideal opportunity to celebrate a famous Welsh win against England in the Six Nations in Cardiff this weekend!
