Prosiect Ysgolion Creadigol- Mae Dosbarth Clwyd (Blwyddyn 6) ar hyn o bryd yn gweithio ar brosiect cyffrous o dan y teil 'Olion'. Daw'r nawdd o gais llwyddiannus i'r Cyngor Celfyddydau. Diben y prosiect yw gweithio gydag ymarferwyr creadigol proffesiynol (Bethan Gwanas- awdur a llenor, Manon Llwyd- Cerddor Proffesiynol ac Emyr Brown- Cynhyrchydd digidol i gynhyrchu adnodd/ gem ddigidol sydd wedi selio ar stori gyffrous yn cyfeirio at hanes y Rhufeiniaid yng Ngogledd Cymru. Edrychwn ymlaen at gael rhannu'r profiadau gyda rhieni'n fuan iawn.

Datblygu'r Ardal tu allan- Prosiect dosbarth Conwy- Mae'n siŵr i chwi sylwi ar ddatblygiad ardal tu allan ger maes parcio rhieni. Ffrwyth llafur dosbarth Conwy yw hyn. Fel rhan o'u gwaith thema, mae'r dosbarth wedi mynd ati i greu corlan i dyfu blodau / llysiau ac ati. Llauer o ddiolch i rieni sydd wedi helpu wrth gyfrannu teiars / offer garddio. 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Dear Parents,

Staffing- Miss Sophia Evans, (Nursery Class teacher) was last week appointed as a permanent member of staff following a shortlisting and interview process. Miss Amy Leigh Roberts was also appointed as a KS2 class teacher on a fixed term contract. She will begin post in September. Congratulations to both.

Sun Policy- We have enjoyed a few weeks of sunshine already this Spring. A good opportunity to remind everyone about our Sun Policy:

*Parents are asked to put sunscreen/sun lotion on their children at home before they arrive school in the mornings. Areas advised are the face, arms and legs.

*Children are encouraged to wear a sunhat / cap at break times/ lunchtimes.

*Children will be advised to shelter under trees when the weather is particularly warm.

Creative Schools Project- The Clwyd Class (Year 6) are currently taking part in an innovating and exciting creative project following a recent successful grant application to be a Lead Creative School. We have managed to secure the services of Bethan Gwanas (Author and Broadcaster, Manon Llwyd, Musician and Emyr Brown- digital engineer) to create an interactive resource based upon literary work surrounding the Romans impact upon North Wales. The intention is to develop fictional account of Romans being transported into 21ST Century Prestatyn. This will be developed into an interactive digital game for pupils (similar to Minecraft) and through the medium of Welsh. The pupils are thoroughly enjoying the experience and look forward to sharing developments with pupils and parents as the work progresses.

Developing the Outdoor Area- The Conwy Class (Year 6) have also been busy developing and unused area next to the school drop off point. The area is being cultivated into an allotment / Well being area to combine wellbeing matters with growing of flowers and vegetables. Many thanks to parents who have helped through donating tyres, gardening tools etc. It's great seeing the children so enthusiastic and enjoying the practical element.

Foundation Phase Update- The Foundation Phase are keen to develop the outdoor area provision in both the Under 5 and 7 Unit. They have exciting plans for outdoor classroom provision and are working with GWE Foundation Phase Officers on ideas. (Details to follow).

School Development Update- The Governing Body are fully supportive in our plans to further develop sheltered areas adjacent to the school dining room. This will offer seated areas for pupils to socialize during break and lunchtimes and also offer additional seating area for the dining room when weather permits. (especially during the summer term). We also have support in principle for developing multi use, all weather sports pitch. The next steps are to ensure costings, including grant applications and matched funding from various organisations. The process will not happen over night as you can imagine, but we are working hard to put plans in place to develop these aspirational projects.

We also intend to develop the current playground at Ysgol y Llys, especially in promoting the Welsh language. We are purchasing notice and display boards which include Welsh idioms, vocabulary and terminology which will add some colour to the playground. Hopefully, they will be put up within the next few weeks.
