Annwyl Rieni,

Dros yr wythnos diwethaf, rydym wedi gweld cynnydd yn yr ysgol o achosion Covid positif ymhlith disgyblion yr ysgol. Ni fedrwn rannu manylion personol achosion, ond gallwn ddatgelu fod nifer o achosion yn benodol ym mlwyddyn 4 gydag achosion eraill i weld hefyd ym Mlwyddyn 5 a 6 ac yn y Cyfnod Sylfaen. Mae cynnydd i weld mewn ysgolion ledled Sir Dinbych, gan gynnwys yr ysgolion uwchradd.

Yma yn Ysgol y Llys, rydym yn cydweithio'n agos a thîm Orlhain a Phrofi Sir Ddinbych ac yn dilyn canllawiau a gweithdrefnau ysgolion yn unol â chyfarwyddyd Llywodraeth Cymru. Re: Covid Update- Ysgol y Llys

Dear Parents,

Over the last week here at Ysgol y Llys, we have seen a significant rise in the number of pupils showing symptoms of Covid and subsequently being tested positive for Covid. In terms of GDPR, naturally we cannot divulge personal information, but I feel I should share with parents that an increase in numbers are appearing in our Year 4 cohort in KS2 but also cases in Year 5 and 6 and in some Foundation Phase classes.

We are not unique in this, as it appears that transmission is on the increase in most schools across Denbighshire. Indeed, late last week, all secondary schools across Denbighshire were placed on the amber alert system due to increase in Covid transmission among students.

We are co-operating fully and proactively with Denbighshire TTP and following WAG Operational Guidance in terms of correspondence with parents, identifying close contacts etc. As you can imagine, the TTP agency within Denbighshire is under significant pressure. To assist with this, I kindly ask that if your child is tested positive following a PCR result that you contact the school as soon as possible and provide a **screenshot of the result**. We can then as a school issue a DCC 'Warn and Protect' notification to Year group contacts as soon as possible. (Unless we can verify positive cases, we are then dependent on notification and confirmation from TTP).

We are asking for all families, pupils, parents and staff to **be extremely vigilant and thorough** in adhering to **self-distancing measures, good hygiene** and to ensure that should any pupil display symptoms associated with Covid that **they stay at home** and isolate accordingly. Should anyone have any Covid related symptoms, they should book an official PCR test and isolate according to Government guidance. Many families, once a confirmed case is known in a household, decide upon themselves to isolate other siblings until a negative PCR test for other siblings result is returned. Although this is not statutory (Current guidance states that unless pupils show symptoms, they may return to school) this is appreciated by school staff and potentially reduces the risk of further transmission within contact groups.

WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS- Another reminder please that all parents/ visitors are to wear face coverings when on site. We have noticed a marked increase in those who are not wearing, particularly at end of day pick up time. This is for the safety of all. (This request excludes those are exempt due to health or vulnerability status). Thanks for your co-operation.
