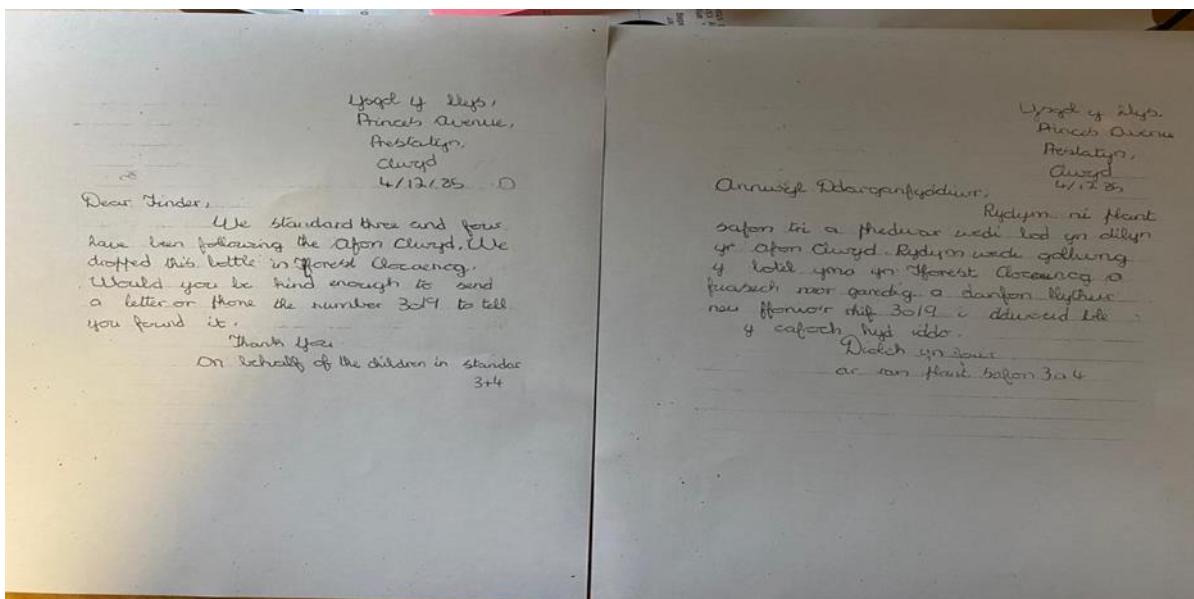

The message was in fact handwritten by Ysgol y Llys pupils.
